### Content of the day.

*Sculpture in Britain underwent remarkable changes in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Through images and discussion, this study day will examine its evolution from conventional representation of the human figure at the beginning of the century, to conceptual work at its close. In between, we shall come across the work of some outstanding artists: Epstein, Gaudier-Brzeska, Moore, Hepworth, Caro and Long amongst them.*

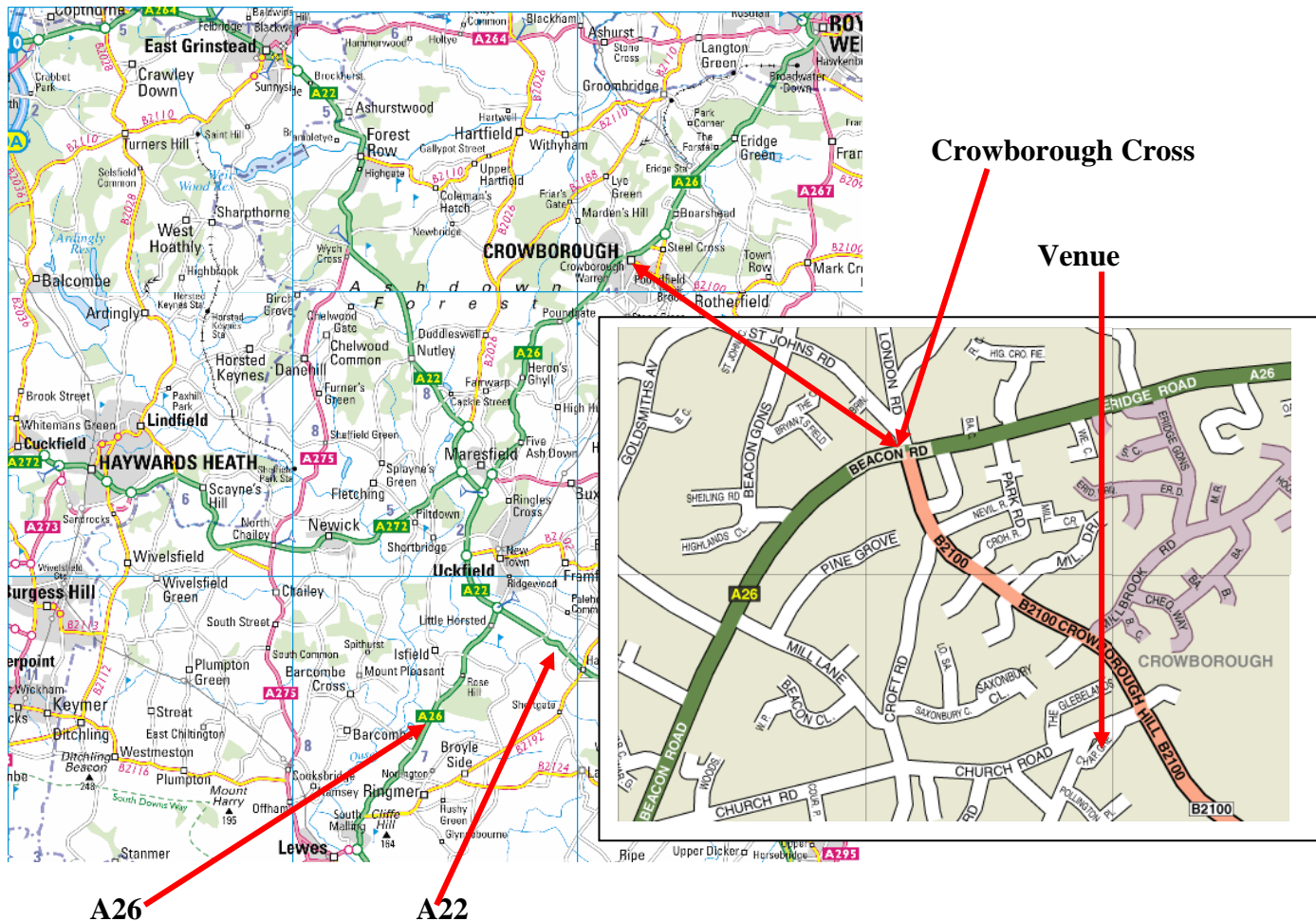
Members of Sussex U3As will be given priority *N.B. A separate cheque is required for each Study Day.* Fees are not normally refunded.
